ABSENCES

Attendance is recorded 9AM each morning. You will need to bring a written note or doctor's excuse for each absence even if you called the previous day.

HOMEROOM ASSIGNMENTS & SCHEDULES

Both Fifth and Sixth grade students will receive a schedule of classes that includes a period that will serve as a homeroom class. Requests for each subject required and 5th/6th grade electives are entered into the computer. The computer system, Skyward, generates the schedule.

We will NOT make changes to any student's schedule based on the following:

Social - Scheduling to be with friends

Elective Change - Changing mind about electives that were already decided upon.

PANTHER HOUR PARTY

Each nine weeks students can earn an admittance to Panther Hour Party. To earn this they must:

- Have no zeros
- Have no more than 3 unexcused absences
- Have no more than 4: leaving early or tardies combined
- Have no more than 1 office referral or ISS placement

CAMPUS CLINIC

A form must be completed if your child requires either prescription or over the counter meds during the school day. Please see our nurse to arrange this. If your child is ill, they will be required to visit the clinic before calling to go home.

CELL PHONES/ ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Students may use electronic devices only when they have permission. They must be on silent and put away at all other times. If your student is using their phone during unauthorized times, it will be taken to the office and a parent will be required to come pick it up.

We cannot be responsible for lost or stolen electronic devices. Students who need to contact parents are asked to report to the school office to use the telephone. Parents who need to contact students during the school day will need to call the office.

 - was offered the opportunity to go to the ZAP Room at lunch on Friday to receive teacher assistance
 - had the weekend to complete and didn't turn in missing work on the next Monday



MORNING ARRIVAL

Students will report to the gym upon arrival to school. They may arrive as soon as 7:15 each morning. Students are dismissed from the gym at 7:45. Arrivals between 7:45 and 7:55 will need to report to their first period class. If your child is tardy and arrives after 7:55, they need to report to the office. Tardies will be counted against your child for Panther Hour eligibility.

BREAKFAST/LUNCH

Breakfast is served in our cafeteria from 7:30-7:55 AM. Cost of Breakfast is: \$2.25. You may eat lunch with your child with the exception of testing days. Please sign in at the office. Please be prepared to show your photo ID for a visitor's tag. Your ID will remain in the office until you sign-out upon leaving. Lunch Prices: Child \$3.50 & Visitor \$4.50. Snacks:

Due to food related allergies, we do not allow peanut products in the classrooms. Foods and snacks containing peanut ingredients are only allowed in the cafeteria.

Please Note: Students are not allowed to pass out birthday invitations at school.

AFTERNOON DISMISSAL

Car Students: We load a double car line, 10 cars at a time beginning at 3:20 p.m. Please watch the teacher with the stop sign directing traffic. Student names will be called 10 at a time using the school car sign that will need to be visible during dismissal.

For safety purposes, if you do not have a BIS car sign, you will be asked to go into the office and present your driver's license to pick up your child. If you need additional car signs for other vehicles that will be picking your child up, they may be purchased for \$3 in the office.

Early Pick-up: Our goal is for students to be at school from "Bell to Bell". We ask that you refrain from picking up your child early except in rare cases, as this can count against their eligibility for the Panther Hour Party.

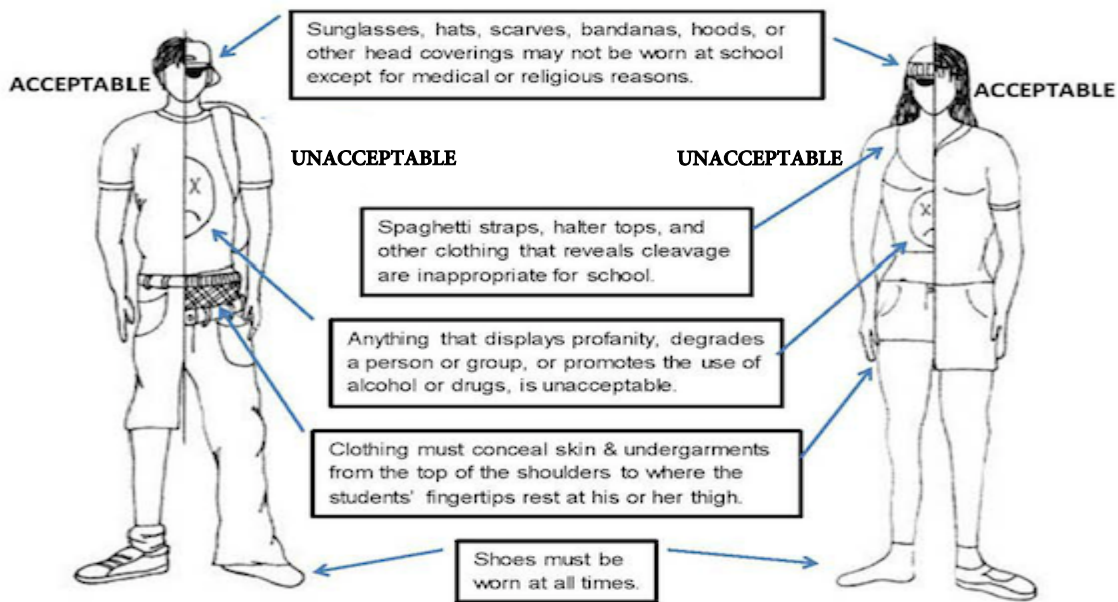
Walkers: Only students who ride home with a Middle School employee are permitted to walk to this campus after school.
